

Website Cookies Policy

By continuing to use our Sites, you are agreeing to our use of cookies in the manner described in this policy.

What are cookies?

A cookie is a small file which asks permission to be placed on your computer's hard drive. Once you agree to our use of cookies, the file is added and the cookie helps us analyse web traffic or lets you know when you visit a particular site. Cookies allow web applications to respond to you as an individual. The web application can tailor its operations to your needs, likes and dislikes by gathering and remembering information about your preferences.

Cookies are an extremely common technology for remembering certain information about a visitor to a website. The vast majority of websites currently make use of cookies and they are commonly used for a wide range of tasks.

The use of cookies help us to provide you with a better website experience by enabling us to monitor which pages you find useful and, similarly, which pages you do not find useful. A cookie in no way gives us access to your computer or any information about you, other than the data you choose to share with us.

You can choose to accept or decline cookies. Most web browsers automatically accept cookies, but you can usually modify your browser setting to decline cookies if you prefer. This may prevent you from taking full advantage of the website.

How do we use cookies?

We use cookies for the following purposes:

STRICTLY NECESSARY COOKIES

Some cookies are required for the operation of our Sites. They include, for example, cookies that enable you to log into secure areas of our Site, or make use of our e-commerce service.

ANALYTICAL COOKIES

They allow us to recognise and count the number of visitors and to see how visitors move around our Site when they are using it. This helps us to improve the way our Sites work, for example, by ensuring that users find the particular service or member of staff they are looking for easily.

FUNCTIONALITY COOKIES

These are used to recognise you when you return to our Sites and to embed functionality from third party services. This enables us to tailor our content specifically for you and remember your preferences.

ADVERTISING COOKIES

These cookies record your visit to our Sites, the pages you have visited on our Sites and others and the links you have followed. We will use this information to make the advertising displayed to you more relevant to your interests. We may also share this information with third parties for this purpose.
